- A. Approve the minutes of the June 20, 2007 Adjourned Regular Meeting and the June 26, 2007 Regular City Council meeting.

- B. Accept a donation in the amount of \$2,500 from First 5 San Bernardino County for use in the Child Protection Fair.
- C. Award bid and authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with California Landscape and Design in the amount of \$45,583 and authorize a 10% contingency in the amount of \$4,558.
- D. Award bid and authorize the City Manager to enter into a two-year contract with B's Pool Services with three one-year extensions at the sole discretion of the City, for the supply and delivery of pool chemicals and supplies to the five pool facilities owned and operated by the City of Fontana.
- E. Award bid and authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract agreement with John Deere Landscape for a two-year period renewable for three additional one-year increments at the City's discretion, for irrigation supplies.
- F. Award bid and authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract agreement with Seibert Security Services for a two-year period renewable for three additional one-year increments at the City's discretion.
- G. Approve eleven co-sponsorship applications received from various organizations for Fiscal Year July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.
- H. Adopt **Ordinance No. 1557**, amending Chapter 15 of the Fontana Municipal Code to prohibit the establishment and operation of businesses prohibited by State of Federal Law.

 - (2) Introduce **Ordinance No** _____, of the City of Fontana amending Chapter 30, Zoning and Development Code to prohibit Medical Marijuana Dispensaries as a land use pursuant to Government Code Section 65858, that the reading of the title constitutes the first reading thereof.
