



Destination: HOME in Fontana is interested in leasing your apartments.

In April 2019, the City of Fontana began its “Destination: HOME” project which aims to prevent and end homelessness for our residents.

Part of the program’s services includes a Housing Assistance Program wherein we provide direct assistance to homeless residents who are looking to find their way off the streets and resume productive and prosperous lives. Our clients, unfortunately, don’t have much in the way of income or credit history to begin with, but we stand behind them and provide them with such assistance as:

- Application fees and deposit assistance
- Rental assistance for typically up to 3 months
- Employment training and assistance
- Financial counseling and budgeting
- Community building
- Tenant rights and responsibilities

To end homelessness, we need landlords and apartment managers who are willing to work with us and that means making sure that you are happy and satisfied working with us. Our team consists of three Advocates who are available to the apartment managers we work with. We are also in active participation with Fontana Police and the Crime-free program. We check in on our clients frequently and while we encourage direct landlord-tenant communication, we also are there for you in case any issues or disputes arise.

Last year, our team, working in another city was able to successfully house 60 people. We have referrals from other managers (and homeowners) who will tell you that they are happy with our tenants and with the relationships we’ve formed with them. We hope you will become part of our community team to improve the lives of those living in Fontana.
